		susceptible to invasive mussels (bump or ridge down center). If found, send to her.  Algae (green, brown, white) already forming. Any algae is a sign of distress in the lake. Barley will naturally decay in the water and destroy green algae – but its bulky and messy and difficult to remove afterward. Legal dredging is an option, but how expensive.  Nowell interested in the depth light mentioned – need to find proper term and maybe look at purchasing.  Website update: Nowell reached out to Breeze, small website starts at \$5,000 with \$1,000 year monitoring. Looking at other options, etc.
